In clarifying hiring procedures, the board concurred personnel will be hired in accordance with SVFPD's written policies and procedures with operations (Chief, Assistant Chief) having discretion. 2021-22 Final budget resolution The proposed adopted budget for fiscal year 2021/2022 includes authorized general, specific and investment revenues one hundred twenty-nine thousand, five hundred dollars (\$129,500); personnel, operating [services and supplies] and capital outlay appropriations of one hundred eighty-eight thousand, five hundred dollars (\$188,500); and appropriations for contingencies of four hundred thirteen thousand, four hundred seventy-eight dollars (\$413,478).
